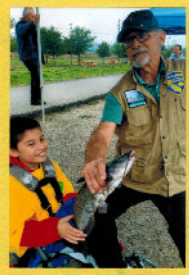
Also assisting us was **Dave Baltes** – Friends of Castaic – for his assistance and guidance in putting the net together

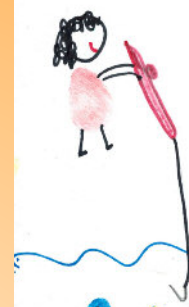

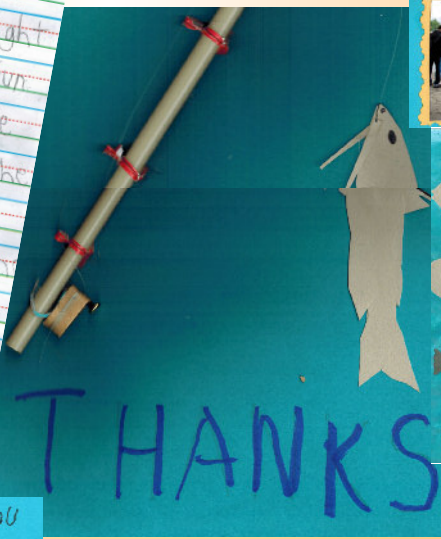

ENVIRONMENTAL NEWS

FISH & WILDLIFE COMMISSION IN FLUX

Several news articles have reported on the two vacancies on this five member board. Hopefully Gov. Brown will make appointments of people who understand hunters and fishermen. A recent article in the LA Times (4/17/16) suggested a major change in the commission. Is it leaning too much in favor of conservation vs. understanding anglers and hunters and their roles ?

The numbers cited are stark! In 1975, with a population of 21.5 million there were 2,289,523 fishing licenses sold. Compare this to 2015, forty years later! With a population of 39 million there were 1,766,080 licenses sold. Fewer angler licenses sold means fewer DFW programs are being financed. As an example it was announced that historically stocked trout weighed 1/2lb. This year the Department stocked 1/4 lb fish...

Pacific Coast Sportfishing reports that the two vacancies may be filled by volunteers. These are Capt. Don Hansen of Dana Wharf Sportfishing who has 40 years of experience in the field. Also coming forward is Steve Greanias who is a licensed Capt. and has a degree in Marine Biology and also holds an MBA in business administration. They might balance out the interests of the "nonoutdoor" members. It is suggested that readers send letters of support to: Gov. DRIFT GILLNETS

In the news for a number of years, it now looks as if the PFMC will o.k. the use of deep buoy gear. This will help restrict the use of drift gillnets which have been opposed for long due their sad history of by-catch of untargeted species.

The drift gillnet issue was brought up at the November '15 PFMC in Garden Grove which some of us attended. Major credit for urging this on behalf of the recreational community should go to Greg Stotesbury of AFTCO, Wayne Kotow of CCA, Geo. Osborn of the California Sportsfishing League, Ed Martin from Harbor Rod & Reel and Theresa Labriola of Wild Oceans. They gave testimony which swayed the PFMC. This was cited in a report by Bob Kurz So. Cal. IFGFA Rep.

THE MARINE LIFE PROTECTION ACT

Established to close off about 800 square miles of our coast to all kinds of fishing in order to protect marine life it was passed only after the it was agreed that a five year period would allow for a new assessment. No plans for such an assessment were announced by the California Fish and Game Commission. Indeed, at the April CFG meeting in Santa Rosa, it was moved to move these Assessments to an every ten year schedule. It appears that certain members of the commission may want to protect the marine life indefinitely.

AND ENDING WITH AN UP BEAT NOTE....

Citing an article in Pacific Coast Sportfishing (4/16): NOAA forecasts warmer than average water through October. These predictions for the eastern Pacific make the local fishing season look good for Southern California. Water temperatures should remain above normal possibly into October.

CALLING ALL COOKS

Poached Salmon in Butter and Wine

The key to a good poached salmon steak is in the temperature of the poaching liquid. Never boil the fish...not even for a few seconds. The poaching liquid should cover the fish and the surface should just shimmer, no big bubbles!

Use a pan large enough to accommodate the fish in one layer. You may cook it in more than one batch. Add the butter and melt it, add the lemon juice, chives and wine to the pan. Add the salmon, reduce the heat and cook covered until it flakes. Do not over cook.

You may double the amount of the poaching medium.

6 salmon steaks (1 inch thick)
6 tbsp. butter

3 tbsp. lemon juice
1/2 c. champagne or white wine
2 tbsp. chives (chopped)

Add salmon. Cover and cook on low heat for 30 minutes. Serve with sour cream dill sauce on top or on side.

SAUCE:

1/2 c. sour cream
1 tbsp. Dijon style mustard
1 tbsp. chopped chives
1 1/2 tsp. sugar
1 tsp. fresh minced dill weed
Combine all ingredients until blended. Refrigerate.
Serve with salmon
